

Wilsonart By You Mural Criteria

Wilsonart defines a 'mural' as any continuous design that spans multiple production sheets and must be affixed to a desired space (wall) to appear virtually seamless. While Wilsonart doesn't actively discourage these types of requests through WXY, there are challenges and limitations as to what can be achieved. We would like to outline a few of these challenges, which could lead to the project being kicked back for revision, or refused outright.

This criteria includes, but is not limited to the following:

- Mural panels must align upon a single axis point.
- Joints between panels must contain a minimum 1/4" reveal (spacing between joints)*
- Panels CAN NOT be pure solid color fills
- Panels must run directionally consistent per job – either all vertical or all horizontal
- Scope and scale of the mural must be fully disclosed upon time of initial inquiry
- Artwork must be broken down into individual panels and supplied to Wilsonart with any included bleed and necessary cut-lines. Wilsonart will not accept a full image reduced in scale that has to be resized and formatted into sheet layouts**

* Laminate sheets may shrink up to 1/4" during the manufacturing process. This is why 'seamless' joints are not recommended

**In some instances, we can provide this service for a fee. This depends on the specifics of the project, and is decided on a project by project basis at Wilsonart's discretion.

It should be noted that Wilsonart will supply a finished HPL sheet of laminate. Wilsonart does not custom cut, nor bond material to the substrate. This requires a professional fabricator/installer. All final mural installation is the sole responsibility of the end user.
